7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The definitions in this section apply  
8 throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

9 (1) "Authorized depository" means a mailbox, post office box, or  
10 rural box used by postal customers to deposit outgoing mail or used by  
11 the postal service to deliver incoming mail.

12 (2) "Letter box" means a receptacle that is used for a specific  
13 address intended or used for the receipt or delivery of mail on a mail  
14 route.

15 (3)(a) "Mail" means a letter, card, parcel, or other material that:

16 (i) Is sent or delivered by means of the postal service;

17 (ii) Has postage affixed by the postal customer or postal service;

18 and

19 (iii) Is placed in an authorized depository or mail receptacle.

20 (b) "Mail" includes articles contained in mail.

21 (4) "Mail receptacle" means a place used by the postal service or  
22 postal customers to place outgoing mail or receive incoming mail.

23 (5) "Postage" means a postal service stamp, permit imprint, meter  
24 strip, or other authorized indication of prepayment for service  
25 provided by the postal service for collection and delivery of mail.

26 (6) "Postal service" means the United States postal service.

27 (7) The phrase "of another" does not include persons with whom the  
28 defendant has a familial, parental, spousal, employment, or other  
29 relationship that would otherwise reasonably allow the defendant to  
30 take, dispose of, or otherwise intercept the person's mail.

31 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** (1) A person commits the crime of  
32 obstruction of mail if the person intentionally obstructs or  
33 unreasonably delays:

34 (a) The passage of the mail; or

35 (b) A carrier or conveyance carrying the mail.

1 (2) Obstruction of mail is a gross misdemeanor.

2 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** (1) A person commits the crime of  
3 destruction of letter boxes if the person knowingly and maliciously:

4 (a) Tears down or destroys a letter box belonging to another; or

5 (b) Breaks open a letter box belonging to another.

6 (2) Destruction of letter boxes is a gross misdemeanor.

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** (1) A person commits the crime of  
8 destruction of mail if the person knowingly and maliciously injures,  
9 destroys, or defaces mail of another that has been deposited in an  
10 authorized depository.

11 (2) Destruction of mail is a class C felony.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** (1) A person commits the crime of mail theft  
13 or receipt of stolen mail if the person knowingly:

14 (a) Takes, or by fraud or deception, obtains mail of another from  
15 a mail receptacle, authorized depository, or mail carrier;

16 (b) Secretes, embezzles, or destroys mail of another;

17 (c) Takes, or by fraud or deception, obtains mail of another that  
18 has been left for collection on or adjacent to an authorized depository  
19 or mail receptacle; or

20 (d) Buys, receives, conceals, or unlawfully possesses mail of  
21 another knowing that the mail was taken, obtained, or embezzled as  
22 described in this subsection.

23 (2) Mail theft or receipt of stolen mail is a class C felony.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** In a prosecution under this chapter, it is  
25 a defense that the defendant acted under an honest claim of right in  
26 that:

27 (1) The defendant was unaware that the property was that of another  
28 person;

29 (2) The defendant reasonably believed that the defendant was  
30 entitled to the property involved or had a right to acquire or dispose  
31 of it as the defendant did; or

32 (3) The property involved was that of the defendant's minor child  
33 or spouse, unless the parties were not living together as husband and  
34 wife and were residing in, and intended to continually reside in,  
35 separate abodes at the time of the alleged offense.

14 If the court finds that a respondent has violated terms of an order,  
15 it may impose a penalty of up to 30 days of confinement.

39 The current offense category is determined by the offense of  
40 adjudication.

41 (2) The horizontal axis of the grid is the number of prior  
42 adjudications included in the juvenile's criminal history. Each prior  
43 felony adjudication shall count as one point. Each prior violation,

1 misdemeanor, and gross misdemeanor adjudication shall count as 1/4  
2 point. Fractional points shall be rounded down.

3 (3) The standard range disposition for each offense is determined  
4 by the intersection of the column defined by the prior adjudications  
5 and the row defined by the current offense category.

6 (4) RCW 13.40.180 applies if the offender is being sentenced for  
7 more than one offense.

8 (5) A current offense that is a violation is equivalent to an  
9 offense category of E. However, a disposition for a violation shall  
10 not include confinement.

12 **OPTION B**

13 **CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY DISPOSITION ALTERNATIVE**

14 If the juvenile offender is subject to a standard range  
15 disposition of local sanctions or 15 to 36 weeks of confinement and has  
16 not committed an A- or B+ offense, the court may impose a disposition  
17 under RCW 13.40.160(5) and 13.40.165.

18 **OR**

19 **OPTION C**

20 **MANIFEST INJUSTICE**

21 If the court determines that a disposition under option A or B would  
22 effectuate a manifest injustice, the court shall impose a disposition  
23 outside the standard range under RCW 13.40.160(2)."
