No notice or agreement is necessary if the electric utility's action is necessary 16

> Provides immunity to an electric utility for cutting EFFECT: vegetation that poses an imminent hazard to the general public if the electric utility notifies the resident or property owner and makes a reasonable effort to obtain an agreement; Allows notice to be given by posting a flier in a conspicuous location and specifies information that must be stated in the notice; Allows the electric utility to act without notice or an agreement under certain circumstances.
