3 On page 90, starting on line 31, strike all of subsection (2)(1)

4 On page 90, after line 30, insert the following:

5 (1)(i)\$2,000,000 of the public safety and education account
6 appropriation is provided for start-up grants for alternative programs
7 and services that improve instruction and learning for at-risk
8 students. Grants shall be awarded to applicants showing the greatest
9 potential for improved student learning for at-risk students including:

10 (A) Students who are disruptive or have been suspended, expelled,
11 or subject to other disciplinary actions;

12 (B) Students with unexcused absences who need intervention;

13 (C) Students who have left school; and

14 (D) Students involved with the court system.

15 (ii) Of the amounts provided under this subsection, \$500,000 shall
16 be awarded based on the criteria enumerated in (1)(i) for programs
17 coordinated with local law enforcement agencies.-

EFFECT: \$500,000 of the funding provided for start-up grants for alternative programs and services that improve instruction and learning for at-risk students is reserved for programs that coordinate efforts with local law enforcement agencies.
