- 24 (3) Unless otherwise provided in subsection (7) of this section the 25 driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person or damage to any vehicle which is driven or 26 27 attended by any person or damage to other property shall give his or her name, address, insurance company, insurance policy number, and 28 vehicle license number and shall exhibit his or her vehicle driver's 29 30 license to any person struck or injured or the driver or any occupant of, or any person attending, any such vehicle collided with and shall 31 render to any person injured in such accident reasonable assistance, 32 including the carrying or the making of arrangements for the carrying 33 34 of such person to a physician or hospital for medical treatment if it 35 is apparent that such treatment is necessary or if such carrying is requested by the injured person or on his or her behalf. Under no 36

circumstances shall the rendering of assistance or other compliance with the provisions of this subsection be evidence of the liability of any driver for such accident.

- (4)(a) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (1) of this section failing to stop or comply with any of the requirements of subsection (3) of this section ((under said circumstances shall be)) in the case of an accident resulting in death is guilty of a class B felony and, upon conviction, is punishable according to chapter 9A.20 RCW.
- (b) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (1) of this section failing to stop or comply with any of the requirements of subsection (3) of this section in the case of an accident resulting in injury is guilty of a class C felony and, upon conviction, ((be punished pursuant to RCW 9A.20.020: PROVIDED, That)) is punishable according to chapter 9A.20 RCW.
- (c) This ((provision)) subsection shall not apply to any person injured or incapacitated by such accident to the extent of being physically incapable of complying ((herewith)) with this section.
- (5) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (2) of this section failing to stop or to comply with any of the requirements of subsection (3) of this section under said circumstances shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor: PROVIDED, That this provision shall not apply to any person injured or incapacitated by such accident to the extent of being physically incapable of complying herewith.
- (6) The license or permit to drive or any nonresident privilege to drive of any person convicted under this section or any local ordinance consisting of substantially the same language as this section of failure to stop and give information or render aid following an accident with any vehicle driven or attended by any person shall be revoked by the department.
- (7) If none of the persons specified are in condition to receive the information to which they otherwise would be entitled under subsection (3) of this section, and no police officer is present, the driver of any vehicle involved in such accident after fulfilling all other requirements of subsections (1) and (3) of this section insofar as possible on his <u>or her</u> part to be performed, shall forthwith report such accident to the nearest office of the duly authorized police authority and submit thereto the information specified in subsection (3) of this section.
