The property tax is authorized only if a majority of at least three-fifths of the registered voters approve the proposition 12 13 authorizing the levy submitted at a general or special election, at which election the number of persons voting "yes" on the proposition 14 shall constitute three-fifths of a number equal to forty percent of the 15 16 total number of voters voting in such taxing district at the last preceding general election when the number of registered voters voting 17 on the proposition does not exceed forty percent of the total number of 18 voters voting in such taxing district in the last preceding general 19 20 election. Included in this ballot proposition shall be the statement 21 that (a) the revenues from the property tax may only be used to fund a zoo; and (b) a stipulation that the city will maintain at least its 22 current funding for its zoo which may be measured by a set dollar 23 amount, a dollar amount to be adjusted by the consumer price index, or 24 25 a percentage of the general fund."
