RCW 75.46.080 and 1998 c 246 s 9 are each amended to read 7 as follows: Representatives from the conservation commission, 8 (1) the 9 department of transportation, and the department of fish and wildlife shall establish an interagency review team. 10 Except as provided in 11 subsection (6) of this section, habitat restoration project lists shall 12 be submitted to the interagency review team by January 1st and July 1st 13 of each year beginning in 1999. 14 (2) If no lead entity has been formed under RCW 75.46.060, the interagency review team shall rank, prioritize, and dispense funds for 15 16 habitat restoration projects by giving preference to the projects that: 17 (a) Provide a greater benefit to salmon recovery; 18 (b) Will be implemented in a more critical area; (c) Are the most cost-effective; 19 20 (d) Have the greatest matched, or in-kind funding; and 21 (e) Will be implemented by a sponsor with a successful record of 22 project implementation. (3) If a lead entity established under RCW 75.46.060 has been 23 formed, the interagency review team shall evaluate project lists and 24 25 may remove, but not add, projects from a habitat project list. 26 (4) The interagency review team shall provide a summary of funding for habitat restoration project lists to the governor and to the 27 28 legislature by December 1st of each year. 29 (5) The interagency review team may annually establish a maximum amount of funding available for any individual project, subject to 30 31 available funding. The interagency review team shall attempt to assure a geographical balance in assigning priorities to projects. 32 (6) For fiscal year 1998, the department of fish and wildlife, the 33 conservation commission, and the department of transportation may 34 35 authorize, subject to appropriations, expenditures for projects that 36 have been developed to restore salmon habitat before completion of the 37 project lists required in RCW 75.46.060(2).

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1 (7) Where a lead entity has been established pursuant to RCW 2 75.46.060, the interagency review team may provide block grants to the 3 lead entity, subject to available funding.

4 (8) Prior to finalizing funding decisions under the provisions of 5 this section, the interagency review team shall consult with interests 6 representing irrigated and non-irrigated agriculture, sport and 7 commercial fishing interests, large and small scale timber interests,

8 conservation districts, and county and city governmental interests."

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EFFECT: Requires the interagency review team to consult with interest groups prior to making fish project funding decisions.
