- 20 (i) There is a correlation between the scores on the state-wide 21 standardized norm-reference assessment and the Washington assessment on 22 student learning;
- 23 (j) Scoring procedures are dependable and free from random errors 24 of measurement;
- 25 (k) The passing standards or cut-scores ensure reasonable student 26 proficiency and are empirically reliable; and
- 27 (1) There is a standardization of test administration."

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EFFECT: Changes the criteria that the State Board of Education must use when making findings to determine whether the high school assessment is reliable and valid.
