26 a number equal to forty percent of the total number of voters voting in  
27 such taxing district at the last preceding general election"

**Effect:** School levy and bonds are approved by a simple majority at general elections, but require the traditional 60/40 requirements to be approved at special elections. A school levy may only be run once per

calendar year.
