6 On page 2, line 5, after "(4)", insert the following:

7 "Notwithstanding any other provision of this Constitution or law,
8 the rate of state property tax shall be as follows:

9 (a) Three dollars and sixty cents per thousand dollars of assessed
10 value for taxes levied for collection in 2000, and before;

11 (b) Three dollars and twenty-four cents per thousand dollars of
12 assessed value for taxes levied for collection in 2001;

13 (c) Two dollars and eighty-eight cents per thousand dollars of
14 assessed value for taxes levied for collection in 2002;

15 (d) Two dollars and fifty-two cents per thousand dollars of
16 assessed value for taxes levied for collection in 2003;

17 (e) Two dollars and sixteen cents per thousand dollars of assessed
18 value for taxes levied for collection in 2004; and

19 (f) One dollar and eighty cents per thousand dollars of assessed
20 value for taxes levied for collection in 2005; and

21 (g) One dollar and forty-four cents per thousand dollars of
22 assessed value for taxes levied for collection in 2006; and

23 (h) One dollar and eight cents per thousand dollars of assessed
24 value for taxes levied for collection in 2007; and

25 (i) Seventy-two cents per thousand dollars of assessed value for
26 taxes levied for collection in 2008; and

27 (j) Thirty-six cents per thousand dollars of assessed value for
28 taxes levied for collection in 2009; and

29 (k) No tax may be levied under this section for taxes levied for
30 collection in 2010 and thereafter.

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EFFECT: Phases out the state property tax by 2010.
