Background: A concern has been raised that children in foster care stay in placement too long. If additional attention was paid to implementing a permanency plan of family reunification or adoption, children would spend less time in foster care placements.

Summary of Bill: The Department of Social and Health Services is directed to reallocate six existing social worker positions into permanency planning and adoption advocates. These staff would be directed to implement children's permanency plans more quickly than is currently the case.
