**Summary of Bill:** The Governor must appoint the elected member of a county legislative authority from one list of three persons provided by the Washington State Association of Counties. The authority creating staggered terms is repealed.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.

**Testimony For:** The counties should be able to recommend elected officials to the Governor for his selection for the Forest Practices Board.
