**Brief Description:** Revising provisions for lake management districts.

**Background:** Existing law authorizes counties to create lake management districts for a period of up to ten years for the purpose of financing improvement and maintenance through special assessments. Any resolution or petition for the creation of a lake management district must include the proposed duration of the district. There is concern that a ten-year limit on duration impedes ability to undertake activities that require long-term financing.

**Summary of Bill:** The ten-year limit on the duration of lake management districts is removed. Dikes, levees, and flumes are added to the list of activities that can be financed.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
