## **SB 6582**

#### As of January 31, 2000

- **Title:** An act relating to exclusion of on and off-ramps of interstate highways from transportation facilities of state-wide significance.
- **Brief Description:** Excluding freeway ramps from state-wide significant transportation facilities.

**Background:** A number of unanswered questions exist regarding the treatment of stateowned transportation facilities as it relates to on and off-ramps in city and county comprehensive plans and development regulations which are required by the state's Growth Management Act (GMA).

Summary of Bill: Interstate highway on and off-ramps are not included as being of statewide significance.

Appropriation: None.

Effective Date: Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
