**Background:** Both general contractors and specialty contractors must file a surety bond when registering with the Department of Labor and Industries. The amount of the bond is \$6,000 for general contractors and \$4,000 for specialty contractors.

**Summary of Substitute Bill:** The amount of the bond is increased to \$15,000 for general contractors and \$8,000 for specialty contractors. Other technical changes are made.

Substitute Bill Compared to Original Bill: The original bill was not considered.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
