- 1 AN ACT Relating to natural area preserves; and creating new 2 sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The department of natural resources shall
- 5 not adopt a new management plan pertaining to any natural area
- 6 preserves in Grays Harbor county and Pacific county before January 10,
- 7 2000.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The house of representatives natural
- 9 resources committee shall study the following aspects of the natural
- 10 area preserves program created under chapter 79.70 RCW:
- 11 (1) The potential impact, if any, of defining natural area preserve
- 12 boundaries which encompass land that has not yet been purchased for the
- 13 program;
- 14 (2) The correlation between the goals and purposes of the natural
- 15 area preserves program and the natural resource conservation area
- 16 program and the potential use of both programs in selected areas;
- 17 (3) The current procedures that ensure the adequacy of local public
- 18 input concerning natural area preserve boundaries and management;
