- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 38.40.060 and 1991 c 25 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Every officer and employee of the state or of any county, city, or
- 7 other ((political)) <u>municipal or quasi-municipal corporation, or any</u>
- 8 subdivision thereof who is a member of the Washington national guard or
- 9 of the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or marine corps reserve of
- 10 the United States, or of any organized reserve or armed forces of the
- 11 United States shall be entitled to and shall be granted military leave
- 12 of absence from such employment for a period not exceeding fifteen days
- 13 during each calendar year. Such leave shall be granted in order that 14 the person may report for active duty, when called, or take part in
