1 AN ACT Relating to military leave for public employees; and
2 amending RCW 38.40.060.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 38.40.060 and 1991 c 25 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Every officer and employee of the state or of any county, city, or
7 other (~~political~~) municipal or quasi-municipal corporation, or any
8 subdivision thereof who is a member of the Washington national guard or
9 of the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or marine corps reserve of
10 the United States, or of any organized reserve or armed forces of the
11 United States shall be entitled to and shall be granted military leave
12 of absence from such employment for a period not exceeding fifteen days
13 during each calendar year. Such leave shall be granted in order that
14 the person may report for active duty, when called, or take part in
15 active training duty or inactive training duty in such manner and at
16 such time as he or she may be ordered to active duty (~~or~~) active
17 training duty, or inactive training duty. Such military leave of
18 absence shall be in addition to any vacation or sick leave to which the
19 officer or employee might otherwise be entitled, and shall not involve

1 any loss of efficiency rating, privileges, or pay. During the period
2 of military leave, the officer or employee shall receive from the
3 state, or the county, city, or other municipal or quasi-municipal
4 corporation, or any political subdivision, his or her normal pay.
