- 1 AN ACT Relating to part-time employees of community and technical
- 2 colleges; and adding a new section to chapter 28B.50 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- The state of Washington desires a skilled and dedicated, well trained work force for the community and technical college system. The legislature finds that community and technical colleges offer quality,
- 9 cost-effective instructional programs to the citizens of the state.
- 10 The legislature finds that adjunct faculty at the community and
- 11 technical colleges have an essential role in providing students with an 12 excellent and affordable education. Stagnated salaries and lack of
- 13 career advancement opportunities within the community college system
- 14 are hindrances to adjunct faculty. Low salaries also create a
- 15 perception of a lack of fairness. The legislature further finds that
- 16 adjunct faculty members make a major contribution to student learning
- 17 in their formal teaching duties and in their nonteaching duties.
- 18 Therefore, it is the intent of the legislature to recognize adjunct
- 19 faculty members for their teaching and for their nonteaching

1 contributions to community colleges. Adjunct faculty should be 2 compensated for all their contributions to students, contributions to 3 faculty, and the furtherance of the community and technical college 4 mission.

Therefore, it is the intent of the legislature that part-time faculty employed in public community and technical colleges receive fair compensation for work when compared to full-time faculty. Fair compensation for work should include the goal of closing the gap between the average adjunct faculty pay rate and the average full-time faculty pay rate. Fair compensation may also include compensation for nonteaching duties performed by adjunct faculty.
