- 1 AN ACT Relating to the use of credit reports by insurers; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 48.05 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.05 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Prior to obtaining a credit report on any person, an insurer 7 shall disclose to the person the intention of the insurer to obtain the
- 8 credit report. If the person requests that the insurer not obtain the
- 9 credit report, the insurer shall not obtain the credit report. Nothing
- 10 in this section restricts the insurer's ability to not quote a rate, to
- 11 deny an application, or to not renew a policy because the person
- 12 refuses to allow the insurer to obtain a credit report on that person.
- 13 (2) For purposes of this section, "credit report" means the same as 14 "consumer report" as defined in RCW 19.182.010.

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
