3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 64.12.030 and Code 1881 s 602 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 Whenever any person ((shall)) cuts down, girdles or otherwise 7 injures, or ((carry)) <u>carries</u> off any tree, timber, or shrub on the land of another person, or on the street or highway in front of any 8 person's house, village, town, or city lot, or cultivated grounds, or 9 10 on the commons or public grounds of any village, town, or city, or on the street or highway in front thereof, without lawful authority, in an 11 12 action by such person, village, town, or city against the person 13 committing such trespasses or any of them, if judgment be given for the plaintiff, it shall be given for the greater of five hundred dollars or 14 15 treble the amount of damages claimed or assessed therefor, as the case 16 may be.
