- 1 AN ACT Relating to defenses in civil actions; and amending RCW 2 4.24.420.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 4.24.420 and 1987 c 212 s 901 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 It is a complete defense to any action for damages for personal
- 7 injury or wrongful death that the person injured or killed was engaged
- 8 in the commission of a felony, a gross misdemeanor, or a misdemeanor at
- 9 the time of the occurrence causing the injury or death and the felony,
- 10 the gross misdemeanor, or the misdemeanor was a proximate cause of the
- 11 injury or death. However, nothing in this section shall affect a right
- 12 of action under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1983, nor shall anything in this section
- 13 affect a right of action under the common law doctrine of attractive
- 14 nuisance when the only offense committed or intended to be committed is
- 15 trespass.
