- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring stops at intersections with
- 2 nonfunctioning signal lights; and adding a new section to chapter 46.61

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Except when directed to proceed by a flagger, police officer, or
- 8 fire fighter, the driver of a vehicle approaching an intersection
- 9 controlled by a traffic control signal that is temporarily without
- 10 power on all approaches or is not displaying any green, red, or yellow
- 11 indication to the approach the vehicle is on, shall consider the
- 12 intersection to be an all-way stop. After stopping, the driver shall
- 13 yield the right of way in accordance with RCW 46.61.180(1) and
- 14 46.61.185.
