1 AN ACT Relating to dissolution of a cultural arts, stadium and
2 convention district; and amending RCW 67.38.160.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 67.38.160 and 1982 1st ex.s. c 22 s 16 are each
5 amended to read as follows:

6 (1) A cultural arts, stadium and convention district established in
7 accordance with this chapter shall be dissolved and its affairs
8 liquidated when so directed by a majority of persons in the district
9 voting on such question. An election placing such question before the
10 voters may be called in the following manner:

11 ~~((1))~~ (a) By resolution of the cultural arts, stadium and
12 convention district governing authority;

13 ~~((2))~~ (b) By resolution of the county legislative body or bodies
14 with the concurrence therein by resolution of the city council of a
15 component city; or

16 ~~((3))~~ (c) By petition calling for such election signed by at
17 least ten percent of the qualified voters residing within the district
18 filed with the auditor of the county wherein the largest portion of the
19 district is located. The auditor shall examine the same and certify to

1 the sufficiency of the signatures thereon: PROVIDED, That to be
2 validated, signatures must have been collected within a ninety-day
3 period as designated by the petition sponsors.

4 With dissolution of the district, any outstanding obligations and
5 bonded indebtedness of the district shall be satisfied or allocated by
6 mutual agreement to the county or counties and component cities of the
7 cultural arts, stadium and convention district.

8 (2) A cultural arts, stadium and convention district established in
9 accordance with this chapter shall be dissolved and its affairs
10 liquidated when directed by a majority vote of the governing body if a
11 ballot proposition under RCW 67.38.110 or 67.38.130, submitted to
12 voters, is not approved.
