1 AN ACT Relating to automobile insurance discounts for older 2 insureds; and adding a new section to chapter 48.19 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 48.19 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 When the spouse of an insured who is fifty-five years of age or 7 older dies, insurance companies writing automobile liability and 8 physical damage insurance in this state shall continue to apply to the 9 premium paid by the surviving insured all discounts associated with 10 marital status and the driving record of the deceased spouse for a 11 period of two years after the death of the spouse or until the insured 12 remarries.
