- 2 amending RCW 9A.36.031; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.36.031 and 1998 c 94 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A person is guilty of assault in the third degree if he or she,
- 7 under circumstances not amounting to assault in the first or second 8 degree:
- 9 (a) With intent to prevent or resist the execution of any lawful
- 10 process or mandate of any court officer or the lawful apprehension or
- 11 detention of himself or another person, assaults another; or
- 12 (b) Assaults a person employed ((as a transit operator or driver))
- 13 by a public or private transit company or a contracted transit service
- 14 provider while that person is performing his or her official duties at
- 15 the time of the assault; or
- 16 (c) <u>Assaults a person using transit equipment, services, or</u>
- 17 <u>facilities; or</u>
- 18 (d) Assaults a ((school bus driver)) person employed by a school
- 19 district transportation service or a private company under contract for

- 1 transportation services with a school district while the ((driver))
- 2 person is performing his or her official duties at the time of the
- 3 assault; or
- 4 ((<del>(d)</del>)) <u>(e)</u> With criminal negligence, causes bodily harm to another
- 5 person by means of a weapon or other instrument or thing likely to
- 6 produce bodily harm; or
- 7  $((\frac{e}{}))$  (f) Assaults a fire fighter or other employee of a fire
- 8 department, county fire marshal's office, county fire prevention
- 9 bureau, or fire protection district who was performing his or her
- 10 official duties at the time of the assault; or
- 11  $((\frac{f}{f}))$  <u>(g)</u> With criminal negligence, causes bodily harm
- 12 accompanied by substantial pain that extends for a period sufficient to
- 13 cause considerable suffering; or
- $((\frac{g}))$  Assaults a law enforcement officer or other employee of
- 15 a law enforcement agency who was performing his or her official duties
- 16 at the time of the assault; or
- 17  $((\frac{h}{h}))$  (i) Assaults a nurse, physician, or health care provider
- 18 who was performing his or her nursing or health care duties at the time
- 19 of the assault. For purposes of this subsection: "Nurse" means a
- 20 person licensed under chapter 18.79 RCW; "physician" means a person
- 21 licensed under chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW; and "health care provider"
- 22 means a person certified under chapter 18.71 or 18.73 RCW who performs
- 23 emergency medical services or a person regulated under Title 18 RCW and
- 24 employed by, or contracting with, a hospital licensed under chapter
- 25 70.41 RCW.
- 26 (2) Assault in the third degree is a class C felony.
