- 1 AN ACT Relating to specialty fertilizer labeling language; amending
- 2 RCW 15.54.340; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** It is the intent of the legislature that the
- 5 labeling language applied to specialty fertilizer products sold in
- 6 Washington state not be so restrictive as to inhibit the sales of such
- 7 products either intrastate or interstate. The wording of the label
- 8 should be acceptable to the American plant food control officials which
- 9 is an organization composed of agricultural regulators from all states.
- 10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 15.54.340 and 1998 c 36 s 6 are each amended to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 (1) Except under (f), (q), and (h) of this subsection, any
- 13 commercial fertilizer distributed in this state shall have placed on or
- 14 affixed to the package a label setting forth in clearly legible and
- 15 conspicuous form the following information:
- 16 (a) The net weight;
- 17 (b) The product name, brand, and grade. The grade is not required
- 18 if no primary nutrients are claimed;

- 2 (d) The name and address of the registrant or licensee. The name 3 and address of the manufacturer, if different from the registrant or 4 licensee, may also be stated;
 - (e) Any information required under WAC 296-62-054;
- (f) ((At a minimum)) Except for specialty fertilizers, the following labeling statement: "This product has been registered with the Washington State Department of Agriculture. When applied as directed, this fertilizer meets the Washington standards for arsenic, cadmium, cobalt, mercury, molybdenum, lead, nickel, selenium, and zinc. You have the right to receive specific information about Washington standards from the distributor of this product.";
- (g) Except for specialty fertilizers, after July 1, 1999, the label must also state: "Information received by the Washington State Department of Agriculture regarding the components in this product is available on the internet at http://www.wa.gov/agr/."; ((and))
- (h) For specialty fertilizers, the following labeling statement:

 "When applied as directed, this product meets the guidelines for metals

 adopted by the association of American plant food control officials";

 and
 - $\underline{(i)}$ Other information as required by the department by rule.
 - (2) If a commercial fertilizer is distributed in bulk, a written or printed statement of the information required by subsection (1) of this section shall accompany delivery and be supplied to the purchaser at the time of delivery.
- 26 (3) Each delivery of a customer-formula fertilizer shall be subject 27 to containing those ingredients specified by the purchaser, which ingredients shall be shown on the statement or invoice with the amount 28 29 contained therein, and a record of all invoices of customer-formula 30 grade mixes shall be kept by the registrant or licensee for a period of twelve months and shall be available to the department upon request: 31 PROVIDED, That each such delivery shall be accompanied by either a 32 statement, invoice, a delivery slip, or a label if bagged, containing 33 34 the following information: The net weight; the brand; the guaranteed 35 analysis which may be stated to the nearest tenth of a percent or to the next lower whole number; the name and address of the registrant or 36 37 licensee, or manufacturer, or both; and the name and address of the 38 purchaser.

1 (4) Any person who distributes a commercial fertilizer in this 2 state shall make available to the purchaser on request, a copy of 3 standards for metals established in RCW 15.54.800.
