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## HOUSE BILL 1557

- 1 AN ACT Relating to membership on the state building code council;
- 2 and amending RCW 19.27.070.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.27.070 and 1995 c 399 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- There is hereby established a state building code council to be appointed by the governor.
- 8 (1) The state building code council shall consist of fifteen
- 9 members, two of whom shall be county elected legislative body members
- 10 or elected executives and two of whom shall be city elected legislative
- 11 body members or mayors. One of the members shall be a local government
- 12 building code enforcement official, and one of the members shall be a
- 13 local government fire service official. Of the remaining nine members,
- 14 one member shall represent general construction, specializing in
- 15 commercial and industrial building construction; one member shall
- 16 represent general construction, specializing in residential and
- 17 multifamily building construction; one member shall represent the
- 18 architectural design profession; one member shall represent the
- 19 structural engineering profession; one member shall represent the

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mechanical engineering profession; one member shall represent the 1 construction building trades; one member shall represent manufacturers, 2 3 installers, or suppliers of building materials and components; one 4 member shall be a person with a physical disability and shall represent the disability community; and one member shall represent the general 5 public. At least six of these fifteen members shall reside east of the 6 7 crest of the Cascade mountains. The council shall <u>also</u> include: 8 members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the 9 house, one from each caucus; two members of the senate appointed by the president of the senate, one from each caucus; the state director of 10 fire protection; and an employee of the electrical division of the 11 department of labor and industries, as ex officio, nonvoting members 12 with all other privileges and rights of membership. Terms of office 13 14 shall be for three years. The council shall elect a member to serve as 15 chair of the council for one-year terms of office. Any member who is appointed by virtue of being an elected official or holding public 16 employment shall be removed from the council if he or she ceases being 17 such an elected official or holding such public employment. 18 19 making any appointments to the building code council, the governor shall seek nominations from recognized organizations which represent 20 the entities or interests listed in this subsection. Members serving 21 on the council on July 28, 1985, may complete their terms of office. 22 shall be filled by alternating appointments from 23 Any vacancy 24 governmental and nongovernmental entities or interests until the 25 council is constituted as required by this subsection.

- 26 (2) Members shall not be compensated but shall receive 27 reimbursement for travel expenses in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 28 43.03.060.
- 29 (3) The department of community, trade, and economic development 30 shall provide administrative and clerical assistance to the building 31 code council.

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
