1 AN ACT Relating to veterans; and amending RCW 41.04.005.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.04.005 and 1996 c 300 s 1 are each amended to read 4 as follows:

5 (1) As used in RCW 41.04.005, 41.16.220, and 41.20.050 "veteran" 6 includes every person, who at the time he or she seeks the benefits of 7 RCW 41.04.005, 41.04.010, 41.16.220, 41.20.050, 41.40.170, 73.04.110, 8 or 73.08.080 has received an honorable discharge or received a 9 discharge for physical reasons with an honorable record and who meets 10 at least one of the following criteria:

(a) The person has served between World War I and World War II or during any period of war, as defined in subsection (2) of this section, as either:

14 (i) A member in any branch of the armed forces of the United15 States;

16 (ii) A member of the women's air forces service pilots;

(iii) A U.S. documented merchant mariner with service aboard an oceangoing vessel operated by the war shipping administration, the office of defense transportation, or their agents, ((during the period)) 1 of armed conflict,)) from December 7, 1941, to ((August 15, 1945))
2 December 31, 1946; or

3 (iv) A civil service crewmember with service aboard a U.S. army 4 transport service or U.S. naval transportation service vessel in 5 oceangoing service ((during the period of armed conflict,)) from 6 December 7, 1941, to ((August 15, 1945)) December 31, 1946; or

7 (b) The person has received the armed forces expeditionary medal, 8 or marine corps and navy expeditionary medal, for opposed action on 9 foreign soil, for service:

(i) In any branch of the armed forces of the United States; or(ii) As a member of the women's air forces service pilots.

12 (2) A "period of war" includes:

13 (a) World War I;

14 (b) World War II;

15 (c) The Korean conflict;

(d) The Vietnam era, which was the period beginning August 5, 1964,and ending on May 7, 1975;

(e) The Persian Gulf War, which was the period beginning August 2,
19 1990, and ending on the date prescribed by presidential proclamation or
20 law;

(f) The period beginning on the date of any future declaration of war by the congress and ending on the date prescribed by presidential proclamation or concurrent resolution of the congress; and

(g) The following armed conflicts, if the participant was awarded
the respective campaign badge or medal: The crisis in Lebanon; the
invasion of Grenada; Panama, Operation Just Cause; Somalia, Operation
Restore Hope; Haiti, Operation Uphold Democracy; and Bosnia, Operation
Joint Endeavor.
