- 1 AN ACT Relating to health and safety; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 70.54 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 70.160 RCW; and
- 3 providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.54 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, tobacco
- 8 products may not be sold or distributed in those portions of buildings
- 9 or vessels that are publicly owned or leased.
- 10 (2) A violation of this section is grounds for the termination or
- 11 nonrenewal of a contract for occupancy or rental of any area of any
- 12 publicly owned or leased building or vessel.
- 13 (3) This section does not apply to correctional institutions.
- 14 However, the secretary of corrections or a local correctional
- 15 institution authority may prohibit sales and distributions of tobacco
- 16 products if the prohibition applies equally to employees and inmates.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.160 RCW
- 18 to read as follows:

p. 1 HB 1665

- 1 This chapter does not preempt local regulation of indoor smoking
- 2 that is as restrictive or more restrictive than this chapter.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Section 2 of this act takes effect January 4 1, 2000.
