- 1 AN ACT Relating to the disposal of state parks and recreation
- 2 commission land in Moses Lake, Washington; creating a new section; and
- 3 declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The state parks and recreation commission
- 6 shall convey to the city of Moses Lake all property located within the
- 7 city of Moses Lake that is currently dedicated to use as a state park,
- 8 and additionally any land owned by the state parks and recreation
- 9 commission that is adjacent to the land currently dedicated to use as
- 10 a state park. The city of Moses Lake shall take all measures necessary
- 11 to accept these lands into ownership.
- 12 The city of Moses Lake shall maintain as a city park all conveyed
- 13 land that is currently dedicated to use as a state park. The title,
- 14 and any other documents necessary for the transfer of these lands, will
- 15 include covenants ensuring that the city of Moses Lake will maintain
- 16 the currently dedicated park land as a city park. If the city of Moses
- 17 Lake breaches these covenants, ownership of the dedicated park lands
- 18 will revert to the state parks and recreation commission.
