1 AN ACT Relating to the disposal of state parks and recreation 2 commission land in Ellensburg, Washington; creating a new section; and 3 declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The state parks and recreation commission 6 shall convey to Kittitas county for use as a fairgrounds that property 7 located within the city of Ellensburg, between Euclid way and Pfenning 8 road, that is currently dedicated to use as a cross-state trail. 9 Kittitas county shall take all measures necessary to accept these lands 10 into ownership.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 13 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 14 immediately.
