The department of revenue shall develop an 5 assessment improvement plan with the objective of improving the uniformity, accuracy, and accountability of property assessments state-6 wide. The plan shall include the development of quidelines and standards for assessment administration, including program management 8 and property classification and valuation. 9 The plan shall provide 10 recommendations on processes and procedures that assure quality assessment administration in the most efficient and cost-effective 11 The plan shall also recommend processes for reviewing and 12 13 reporting on individual county performance, and programs to assist 14 counties to correct noncompliance. The department shall estimate the 15 cost and time required to implement the plan. The department shall 16 submit the plan to the committee on finance of the house of
