- 1 AN ACT Relating to vehicles boarding ferries; adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 46.61 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 47.60 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 It is a traffic infraction for a driver of a motor vehicle
- 7 intending to board a Washington state ferry, to: (1) Block a
- 8 residential driveway while waiting to board the ferry; or (2) move in
- 9 front of another vehicle in a queue already waiting to board the ferry,
- 10 without the authorization of a state ferry system employee. Vehicles
- 11 qualifying for preferential loading privileges under rules adopted by
- 12 the department of transportation are exempt from this subsection. In
- 13 addition to any other penalty imposed for a violation of this section,
- 14 the driver shall be directed to immediately move the motor vehicle to
- 15 the end of the queue of vehicles waiting to board the ferry.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 47.60 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:

- 1 The department shall take steps to mitigate problems associated
- 2 with lengthy ferry queues, including the blockage of residential
- 3 driveways, by implementing appropriate mitigation procedures and any
- 4 feasible infrastructural changes to enforce section 1 of this act.
