- 1 AN ACT Relating to requirements for graduation from high school;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 28A.230 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.230 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) No school district may issue a high school diploma to any 7 person who by way of age and gender appears to be subject to the United 8 States military selective service act unless:
- 9 (a) That person displays proof of having registered with the 10 selective service system in accordance with the military selective 11 service act; or
- 12 (b) That person is not required to register with the selective 13 service system and files with the school district a written statement 14 citing the applicable federal law and certifying that registration with 15 the selective service system is not required.
- 16 (2) The state board of education shall adopt rules to carry out the 17 provisions of this section by June 1, 2002.
