## HOUSE BILL 1939

1 AN ACT Relating to theft by public officers or employees; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 9A.56 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that public officers and public employees hold a special position of trust as public servants, and as fiduciaries of that trust must be held to a higher standard of accountability for criminal actions that result in the theft of government property or services paid for with public funds.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.56 RCW 10 to read as follows:

11 A public officer or employee who is convicted of theft of any 12 property or service, where the property or service was government 13 property or a government service, or was paid for, in whole or in part, 14 with public funds, shall serve no less than one-third the maximum time 15 of confinement imposed within the sentence range for the offense based
