1 AN ACT Relating to the state work-study program; adding a new
2 section to chapter 28B.12 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that welfare reforms
5 have been successful in encouraging and supporting recipients of public
6 assistance to move into the work force. In order to continue and
7 enhance the successful results of welfare reform, the legislature
8 intends to resolve the conflicting requirements of welfare reform to
9 work at least twenty hours per week with the prohibition against
10 working more than nineteen hours per week under the state work-study
11 financial aid program.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.12 RCW
13 to read as follows:

14 State reimbursement under the work-study program shall not be
15 limited to an average of a maximum of nineteen hours per week in the

1 case of an undergraduate student or twenty hours per week in the case
2 of on-campus graduate assistants.
