AN ACT Relating to excise tax exemptions related to horses; adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 This chapter shall not apply to any person in respect to the 9 business of boarding, breeding, training, or selling horses.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 11 to read as follows:

12 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of feed 13 for horses.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW 15 to read as follows:

16 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the 17 use of feed for horses.

1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate 2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 3 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 4 July 1, 1999.
