- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.165 and 1998 c 245 s 90 are each amended to read as follows: 5
- 6 The state department of transportation and the local authorities 7

are authorized to reserve all or any portion of any highway under their

- respective jurisdictions as high-occupancy vehicle lanes, including any 8
- designated lane or ramp, for the exclusive or preferential use of 9
- 10 public transportation vehicles or private motor vehicles carrying no
- fewer than a specified number of passengers when such limitation will 11
- increase the efficient utilization of the highway or will aid in the 12
- 13 conservation of energy resources. ((There is hereby appropriated from
- 14 the transportation fund--state to the department of transportation,
- 15 program C for the period ending June 30, 1993, an additional \$15
- 16 million for the sole purpose of expediting completion of the HOV core
- 17 lane system.)) Regulations authorizing such exclusive or preferential
- use of a highway ((facility may be declared to be)) are effective ((at 18
- 19 all times or at specified times of day or on specified days)) only from
