## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2099

- 1 AN ACT Relating to an exemption from relinquishment of a water
- 2 right for nonuse resulting from the operation or pendency of legal
- 3 proceedings; amending RCW 90.14.140; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.14.140 and 1998 c 258 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) For the purposes of RCW 90.14.130 through 90.14.180,
- 8 "sufficient cause" shall be defined as the nonuse of all or a portion
- 9 of the water by the owner of a water right for a period of five or more
- 10 consecutive years where such nonuse occurs as a result of:
- (a) Drought, or other unavailability of water;
- 12 (b) Active service in the armed forces of the United States during
- 13 military crisis;
- (c) Nonvoluntary service in the armed forces of the United States;
- 15 (d) The operation or pendency of a proceeding initiated under RCW
- 16 <u>90.03.110 through 90.03.240 or 90.44.220 and 90.44.230 or other</u> legal
- 17 proceedings concerning the water right or appurtenant real property;

- 1 (e) Federal or state agency leases of or options to purchase lands 2 or water rights which preclude or reduce the use of the right by the 3 owner of the water right;
- 4 (f) Federal laws imposing land or water use restrictions either 5 directly or through the voluntary enrollment of a landowner in a 6 federal program implementing those laws, or acreage limitations, or 7 production quotas.
- 8 (2) Notwithstanding any other provisions of RCW 90.14.130 through 90.14.180, there shall be no relinquishment of any water right:
- 10 (a) If such right is claimed for power development purposes under 11 chapter 90.16 RCW and annual license fees are paid in accordance with 12 chapter 90.16 RCW;
- (b) If such right is used for a standby or reserve water supply to 14 be used in time of drought or other low flow period so long as 15 withdrawal or diversion facilities are maintained in good operating 16 condition for the use of such reserve or standby water supply;
- 17 (c) If such right is claimed for a determined future development to 18 take place either within fifteen years of July 1, 1967, or the most 19 recent beneficial use of the water right, whichever date is later;
- 20 (d) If such right is claimed for municipal water supply purposes 21 under chapter 90.03 RCW;
- (e) If such waters are not subject to appropriation under the applicable provisions of RCW 90.40.030; or
- (f) If such right or portion of the right is leased to another person for use on land other than the land to which the right is appurtenant as long as the lessee makes beneficial use of the right in accordance with this chapter and a transfer or change of the right has been approved by the department in accordance with RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.383, 90.03.390, or 90.44.100.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Section 1(1)(d) of this act applies retroactively to the commencement of general adjudication proceedings under chapter 90.03 RCW in superior court for the Yakima river basin in October 1977.
