1 AN ACT Relating to labeling requirements for meat and poultry 2 products; adding a new section to chapter 16.49A RCW; and adding a new 3 section to chapter 16.74 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 16.49A RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 Every retail meat dealer is required to place or have placed on the 8 packaging of all meat food products grown or processed outside this 9 state a label advising the consumer, in clear and concise terms, that 10 the product was not grown or processed in Washington state.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 16.74 RCW 12 to read as follows:

Every person who sells poultry products directly to consumers is required to place or have placed on the packaging of all poultry products grown or processed outside this state a label advising the

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- 1 consumer, in clear and concise terms, that the product was not grown or
- 2 processed in Washington state.

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
