1 AN ACT Relating to labeling requirements for meat and poultry
2 products; adding a new section to chapter 16.49A RCW; and adding a new
3 section to chapter 16.74 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 16.49A RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 Every retail meat dealer is required to place or have placed on the
8 packaging of all meat food products grown or processed outside this
9 state a label advising the consumer, in clear and concise terms, that
10 the product was not grown or processed in Washington state.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 16.74 RCW
12 to read as follows:

13 Every person who sells poultry products directly to consumers is
14 required to place or have placed on the packaging of all poultry
15 products grown or processed outside this state a label advising the

1 consumer, in clear and concise terms, that the product was not grown or
2 processed in Washington state.

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
