- 1 AN ACT Relating to services for persons with autism; creating a new
- 2 section; making appropriations; and providing an expiration date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature finds that services to
- 5 people with developmental disabilities should reflect the principle of
- 6 personal choice in selecting appropriate community residential
- 7 services.
- 8 (2) The department of social and health services shall conduct a
- 9 pilot project to test an alternative service delivery model for
- 10 services to persons with autism. The department shall select a pilot
- 11 site using the request for proposal process. The department shall
- 12 evaluate the project and report its findings and conclusions by
- 13 December 1, 2001.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) The sum of two hundred twenty-seven
- 15 thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 16 appropriated from the general fund to the department of social and
- 17 health services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, to carry out
- 18 the purposes of this act.

- 1 (2) The sum of three hundred seventy thousand dollars, or as much 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund to 3 the department of social and health services for the fiscal year ending 4 June 30, 2001, to carry out the purposes of this act.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act expires January 1, 2002.
