- 1 AN ACT Relating to streamlining the implementation of salmon
- 2 recovery; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. Any state agency involved in the
- 5 implementation of salmon preservation and restoration efforts shall
 - identify actual and potential problems in such implementation that are
- 7 attributable to interagency performance. In addition, these agencies
- 8 shall report to the legislature by September 1, 1999, regarding
- 9 identified problems. The report shall include a proposed method for
- 10 streamlining the implementation of salmon preservation and restoration
- 11 efforts, particularly pertaining to interagency cooperation. Further,
- 12 any agency may additionally report to the legislature regarding
- 13 problems in the implementation of salmon preservation and restoration
- 14 efforts attributable to interagency performance at any time after
- 15 September 1, 1999.

- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
