- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:

- (1) The legislature finds that:
- 7 (a) Hepatitis A, a viral infection of the liver, is a serious
- 8 disease to which the severity increases with age;
- 9 (b) Transmission is highly variable spreading from person to person 10 directly or through contaminated food;
- 11 (c) The most effective means of preventing hepatitis A is through
- 12 universal immunization;
- 13 (d) Washington state's high rate of hepatitis A places it as one of
- 14 the top ten states in the nation; and
- 15 (e) The centers for disease control have established a vaccine
- 16 program that is without cost to states with such high rates of
- 17 hepatitis A.
- 18 (2) The department is directed to present a hepatitis A vaccination
- 19 plan, and seek funding for such a plan through the centers for disease
