1 AN ACT Relating to appropriations for disaster relief, fire
2 suppression, and national guard activation during the 1997-99 fiscal
3 biennium; amending 1998 c 346 s 128 (uncodified); making
4 appropriations; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** 1998 c 346 s 128 (uncodified) is amended to read as
7 follows:

3 The appropriations in this section are subject to the following
4 conditions and limitations:

5 (1) \$365,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
6 year 1998, (((\$1,145,000)) \$5,468,000 of the general fund--state
7 appropriation for fiscal year 1999, \$3,000,000 of the flood control
8 assistance account appropriation, and \$6,197,000 of the general fund--
9 federal appropriation are provided solely for deposit in the disaster
10 response account to cover costs pursuant to subsection (2) of this
11 section.

12 (2) (((\$25,122,000)) \$27,996,000 of the disaster response account--
13 state appropriation is provided ((solely)) for the state share of
14 response and recovery costs associated with federal emergency
15 management agency (FEMA) disaster number 1079 (November/December 1995
16 storms), FEMA disaster 1100 (February 1996 floods), FEMA disaster 1152
17 (November 1996 ice storm), FEMA disaster 1159 (December 1996 holiday
18 storm), FEMA disaster 1172 (March 1997 floods), FEMA disaster 1252
19 (1998 northeast counties floods), FEMA disaster 1255 (1998 Kelso
20 landslide), or the state share of response and recovery costs
21 associated with FEMA declared disasters occurring between February 1,
22 1999, and June 30, 1999, and to assist local governmental entities with
23 the matching funds necessary to earn FEMA funds for FEMA disaster 1100
24 (February 1996 floods). (((\$356,000)) \$1,805,000 of the disaster
25 response account--state appropriation is provided solely for fire
26 mobilization costs. \$9,000 of the disaster response account--state
27 appropriation is provided solely for costs associated with FEMA
28 disaster 1182 (Pend Oreille county 1997 spring flood). The military
29 department may, upon approval of the director of the office of
30 financial management, use portions of the disaster response account--
31 state appropriation to offset costs of new disasters occurring before
32 June 30, 1999.

33 (3) \$100,000 of the general fund--state fiscal year 1998
34 appropriation and \$100,000 of the general fund--state fiscal year 1999
35 appropriation are provided solely for the implementation of a
36 conditional scholarship program pursuant to chapter 28B.103 RCW.

37 (4) \$35,000 of the general fund--state fiscal year 1998
38 appropriation and \$35,000 of the general fund--state fiscal year 1999

1 appropriation are provided solely for the north county emergency
2 medical service.

3 (5) \$36,000 of the general fund--state fiscal year 1998
4 appropriation and \$72,000 of the general fund--state fiscal year 1999
5 appropriation are provided solely for emergency worker claims pursuant
6 to chapter 38.52 RCW.

7 (6) \$825,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
8 year 1999 is provided solely for reimbursement of costs associated with
9 activation of the Washington national guard for preserving the peace at
10 the July 1998 Makah days celebration.

11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of six million three hundred ninety
12 thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
13 appropriated from the general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,
14 1999, to the department of natural resources for emergency fire
15 suppression activities during the 1998 wildfire season.

16 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
18 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
19 immediately.

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
