- 1 AN ACT Relating to school safety programs; creating new sections;
- 2 making appropriations; providing an effective date; and declaring an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The sum of four million dollars, or as much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund to
- 7 the superintendent of public instruction for the biennium ending June
- 8 30, 2001, for:
- 9 (1) Alternative school start-up grants which are in addition to the
- 10 grants funded in the two million dollars alternative school start-up
- 11 appropriation contained in section 501(2)(1), chapter 309, Laws of
- 12 1999, and these grants shall be awarded in the same manner and for the
- 13 same purposes;
- 14 (2) School safety programs for prevention and intervention.
- 15 Educational service districts, jointly with school districts, may apply
- 16 for grants. The funds may be expended for proven-effective programs to
- 17 improve safety in schools, including: Security assessments of school
- 18 facilities; violence prevention and reporting training for staff as
- 19 appropriate to the particular duties and responsibilities of the

- 1 specific staff, including administrators; nonviolence and leadership
- 2 training for staff and students; establishing local hot lines; and
- 3 school safety plans. The programs may be provided by educational
- 4 service districts or consortiums of educational service districts or
- 5 local school districts. The educational service districts and school
- 6 districts may contract for any services under this subsection.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of three million dollars, or as much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund to
- 9 the superintendent of public instruction for the biennium ending June
- 10 30, 2001, for matching grants to enhance security in schools. This
- 11 appropriation is a supplement to the five million nine hundred twenty-
- 12 three thousand dollars school security appropriation contained in
- 13 section 501(2)(e), chapter 309, Laws of 1999, and shall be expended in
- 14 the same manner and for the same purposes.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The biennial appropriations in this act
- 16 shall be allotted by the office of financial management evenly between
- 17 fiscal year 2000 and fiscal year 2001.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 19 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 20 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 21 July 1, 1999.
