- 15 (5) Spirits, beer, and wine license;
- 16 (6) Spirits, beer, and wine private club license;
- 17 (7) Tavern license;
- 18 (8) Sports/entertainment facility license; or

- 1 (9) Microbrewery license, a domestic brewery license, or a domestic
- 2 winery license, unless the licensee under this subsection does not

3 allow the consumption of liquor on the premises.
