1 AN ACT Relating to the financial responsibility of certain persons
2 who serve liquor; and adding a new section to chapter 66.08 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.08 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 The board shall require any person who has any of the following
7 licenses to obtain and maintain liability insurance of at least three
8 hundred thousand dollars or a bond of at least three hundred thousand
9 dollars with a surety authorized to conduct a surety business in this
10 state:

- 11 (1) Beer and/or wine license;
- 12 (2) Private club beer and wine license;
- 13 (3) Public house license;
- 14 (4) Snack bar license;
- 15 (5) Spirits, beer, and wine license;
- 16 (6) Spirits, beer, and wine private club license;
- 17 (7) Tavern license;
- 18 (8) Sports/entertainment facility license; or

1 (9) Microbrewery license, a domestic brewery license, or a domestic
2 winery license, unless the licensee under this subsection does not
3 allow the consumption of liquor on the premises.
