1 AN ACT Relating to escorted leaves of absence for prison inmates; 2 and amending RCW 72.01.370.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 72.01.370 and 1992 c 7 s 53 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 The superintendent of any state correctional facility may, subject 7 to the approval of the secretary and under RCW 72.01.375, grant 8 escorted leaves of absence to inmates confined in such institutions to:

9 (1) Go to the bedside of the inmate's wife, husband, child, mother 10 or father, or other member of the inmate's immediate family who is 11 seriously ill;

(2) Attend the funeral of a member of the inmate's immediate familylisted in subsection (1) of this section;

14 (3) Participate in ((athletic contests)) prerelease planning;

(4) Perform work in connection with the industrial, educational, oragricultural programs of the department;

17 (5) Receive necessary medical or dental care which is not available18 in the institution; and

1 (6) Participate as a volunteer in community service work projects 2 which are approved by the superintendent, but only inmates who are 3 nonviolent offenders may participate in these projects. Such community 4 service work projects shall only be instigated at the request of a 5 local community.
