- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.56.080 and 1986 c 257 s 32 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) Every person who, with intent to sell or exchange and to
- 8 deprive or defraud the lawful owner thereof, willfully takes, leads, or
- 9 transports away, conceals, withholds, slaughters, or otherwise
- 10 appropriates any horse, mule, cow, heifer, bull, steer, swine, ((or))
- 11 goat, sheep, donkey, bison, llama, alpaca, or ratite bird is quilty of
- 12 theft of livestock in the first degree.
- 13 (2) A person who commits what would otherwise be theft of livestock
- 14 in the first degree but without intent to sell or exchange, and for the
- 15 person's own use only, is guilty of theft of livestock in the second
- 16 degree.
- 17 (3) Theft of livestock in the first degree is a class B felony.
